Jesus did not take up His Cross in order to show us how to die, but to show us how to live.


Let us as a community of faith make this pilgrimage with Jesus Our Lord, commemorating His unconditional and perfect Love for us.

Father, grant us the grace not to condemn love but to live love and to follow the path to divine humanity.

<u>Leader</u>: Let us pray in silence for those who experience no love in their lives. The orphans, marginalized, neglected and downtrodden.

All : O Jesus, so meek and uncomplaining, teach us resignation in trials.



Mathew 27:28

They stripped off his clothes and put a scarlet robe on him. Then they made a crown out of thorny branches and placed it on his head, and put a stick in his right hand; then they knelt before him and made fun of him. "Long live the King of the Jews!" they said. They spat on him and took the stick and hit him over the head. When they had finished making fun of him, they took the robe off and put his own clothes back on him. Then they led him out to crucify him.



Leader: Lord Jesus crucified


All : By Your second fall, preserve me from relapse into sin.

Flours from Colvery's mountain



<u>Leader</u>: Let us pray in silence for all suffering from the effects of war, starvation and misery.



All : We pray that Mary will also receive us in her arms and


obtain for us contrition for all our sins.
